- Teach life skills:** teach shelter clients skills such as: basic cooking skills, cost-effective meal planning and shopping, ideas for quick-and-easy-to-prepare meals, budgeting, job search skills, health and nutrition education, new-mom support, and more
- Visitation/Exchange:** provide program support to help increase safety for victims and children during custody exchanges and/or supervised visits
- Support Clients:** donate bus passes, gift cards (Safeway, Raleys, K-Mart, Ross, Rite Aid), gift certificates (McDonald's, haircuts, manicures)
- Host a Party:** organize a holiday/birthday/anniversary/other party and invite your friends to learn more about the important services South Lake Tahoe Women's Center provides in our community; encourage donations to the Center instead of gifts.
